WE ARE LEARNING

Writing – In writing Y4 are focusing on using prepositions as fronted adverbials and a variety of subordinating conjunctions. Year 3 are beginning to extend sentences to add more detail by using a variety of subordinating conjunctions at the start of a sentence to write a complex sentence.

Maths – We are finishing addition and subtraction. Pupils in Y4 are currently subtracting 4-digit numbers using renaming whilst Year 3 are subtracting 3-digit numbers with renaming.

Topic – Our Topic is rivers. Pupils are learning how a river is formed, the difference between the upper, middle and lower course of a river, erosion and deposition. Pupils will understand why many towns are situated near rivers and flooding.
